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§1 Introduction

This year we are celebrating the Feast of Tabernacles in the House of Life. And we invite you to join us in tabernacling with Father God, Yeshua and the Holy Spirit.

We want to sit enjoying the communion of His Presence, to worship, to pray the prayers He gives us, to fellowship with one another, to eat and drink together, to explore creative arts in worship and above all else BE before Him.

§2 Dates

We will start with a Shabbat Meal on Friday 25th September 2026 at 18:00 hours and finish with the Shabbat Meal on Friday 2nd October 2026. You can join us for the whole week or for a few days or just for a few hours.

§6 Geography

The House of Life (HoL) is in the village of **Brzezinka**, which is in the vicinity of the town of Oświęcim.

Oświęcim is the main town and is a 9-minute drive (or 1 hour walk) from the House of Life. It offers a variety of restaurants, shops, accommodation, etc. It is now a very pretty town with cafes, parks and lovely walks along the river.

Within walking distance of the House of Life (HoL) on the other side of the railway line is an area called **Zasole**. This is where you will find Oświęcim railway station (24-minute walk from the HoL) and Auschwitz 1. It has a few places to eat, supermarkets and bus stops. The Niva Centrum is a shopping mall 32-minute walk away and offers Carrefour and various shops.

§7 Accommodation

Participants are responsible for their own accommodation. This can be booked through websites/apps like [Booking.com](https://www.booking.com), [AirBnB.com](https://www.airbnb.com), Google maps etc.

Some tips to help you book:

Oświęcim offers all sorts of accommodation at prices that suit most budgets such as self-catering apartments, hotels and hostels. Some Polish hotels also have rooms with kitchenettes or communal kitchens where you can prepare your own food.

Accommodation in Poland is usually very clean and now to a high standard.

Check out the facilities and reviews on the website/app.

We will provide lunch, but you will need to sort out your own breakfast and evening meal, so you may want to think about whether you want self-catering or want to be near restaurants.

Look on the map of the website/app and search for accommodation.

If you want to be near to the House of Life, enter the address Boczna 2, 32-600 Brzezinka, Poland and see what is available.

§8 Transport

Airport

The nearest airport is Kraków - Międzynarodowy Port Lotniczy im. Jana Pawła II Kraków-Balice. It is 60km away / an hour's drive.

From the Airport:

Hire Car: Probably the best and easiest option if you can drive – recommend to prebook.

Taxi: Expensive!

Uber: Maybe possible – no experience and also maybe expensive!

Train: You can catch a train to Oświęcim from the airport, changing trains either at Krakow Główny (Central Train Station In Krakow) or Kraków-Bronowice. Check timetables at the airport. Buy the ticket when you get to the airport. We do not recommend prebuying the train ticket from an agency. They will probably over charge (10x the cost) and you need a ticket for a specific train company.

Your destination train station is Oświęcim, which is 1,7km away (24-minutes walk) from the HoL.

Bus: You will need to get to the central Bus and Train Station in Krakow. Also be prepared to do your own research. We cannot recommend this method unless you are fluent in Polish and it is not much cheaper than the train. **Your destination bus stop is Dworzec PKP** by Oświęcim train station, which is 1,7km away (24-minutes walk) from the HoL.

Local Transport within Oświęcim:

Google maps is a good source for finding trains and buses and their times.

Bus: The nearest bus stop to the HoL is the **MKZ bus stop** in ul. Stanisławy Leszczyńskiej, which is one km away (14-minute walk). Use Google maps to help you.

Another bus stop is **Oświęcim Zasole Walcownia**, Więżniów Oświęcimia (19-minute walk).

Auschwitz Shuttle Bus: There is a shuttle bus between the former camps of Auschwitz and Auschwitz-Birkenau. Sometimes they only allow you on if you have an entrance ticket for Auschwitz. The House of Life is a 7-minute walk from the stop by Auschwitz-Birkenau's main gate.

Taxi and Ubers: For local trips are not expensive.

§9 Food

We will provide lunch, but you will need to sort out your own breakfast and evening meal.

We will supply teas, coffee, snacks. You can help yourself anytime in the dining area.

For restaurants look at Googlemaps or TripAdvisor for suggestions and reviews.

§11 What to bring

You need to bring slippers/house shoes – we have a no outdoor shoes policy in the house.

You may also like to bring a **drink bottle** with lid for drinks in the prayer room – no food or cups/mugs in the prayer room.

Bring yourselves, an open heart, your journal and pen, Bible, musical instrument, art materials.

Nearest Pharmacy (also 24 hour)

The nearest pharmacy (Apteka) is [Apteka Blisko Ciebie. Więżniów Oświęcimia 7A, 32-600 Oświęcim](#). It is open 24 hours and usually has someone who speaks English. It is 23-minute walk away or 4 minutes in the car.
